


Thank you for responding to our students participating at Festival. We could not serve our students without your assistance.

- Be respectful of the work and the process.
- Realize yours is only one viewpoint.
- Be truthful and constructive.
- Be inclusive and specific.
- Respond rather than redirect. Talk about what you experienced.
- Do not turn the response over to audience discussion.
- Offer praise **and** challenges.
- A good guideline is praise two or three things for every challenge given.





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
